By 2025, The South African Plastics Pact aims to change the way plastic products and packaging are designed, used and reused to ensure that plastics are valued and never become waste, by;

- Taking action on unnecessary and problematic packaging and plastic products through design, innovation or alternative delivery models.
- 100% of plastic packaging to be reusable, recyclable or compostable* by 2025 (*applicable only in closed loop and controlled systems with sufficient infrastructure available or fit for purpose applications).
- 70% of plastic packaging effectively (input recycling rate) recycled by 2025.
- 30% average post-consumer recycled content across all plastic packaging.

As a South African Plastics Pact signatory, your organisation commits working towards delivering these targets by:

- Taking action on unnecessary and problematic packaging and plastic products;
- Ensuring all plastic packaging is recycled in practice in South Africa;
- Using recycled plastic in your packaging and products where possible.

All businesses signing up to the South African Plastics Pact will need to contribute to funding facilitation of the South African Plastics Pact. The fees for the first year of the SA Plastics Pact, April 2020 to March 2021, have been decided upon by the Steering Committee based on annual turnover of members and the activities required to deliver on the initiative.
